

### School Attendance:

Attending school regularly helps children feel better about school—and themselves.

As you set goals for the New Year, we must stress to families the importance of school attendance. Did you know that missing 18 days of school over the entire school year is considered "chronic absenteeism"? The research is very clear about the negative impact it has on students right from Kindergarten.

#### Here are some attendance facts:

- Chronic absence in Kindergarten is associated with lower academic performance in first grade, and the learning gap continues to grow each year if attendance rates don't improve.
- Poor attendance can influence whether children can read proficiently at the end of Grade 3.
- By Grade 6, chronic absence becomes a leading indicator that a student will drop out of high school.

### The foundation for success begins in elementary school.


### What You Can Do

- Set a regular bedtime and morning routine.
- Lay out clothes and pack backpack the night before.
- Try to schedule appointments and extended vacations when school is not in session.

Being away just 2 days a month can add up very quickly over the year. How many days has your child missed this year? If you are unsure, please check the last report card or connect with your classroom teacher. We want to support you to ensure your child is at school and is successful not just this year, but in the years to come. ## KINDERGARTEN

Children who will turn five years old before January 1, 2024 are eligible to begin school in September 2023

Registration begins in Surrey Schools Monday, January 16, 2023

#### THE SURREY SCHOOL DISTRICT IS NOW USING A WEB-BASED ONLINE REGISTRATION FORM

Once submitted, the form and any supporting documents will be available to school staff and the Principal who will use their judgement to determine if documentation requirements have been satisfied.

The following documents are required to complete the registration process and may be uploaded to the registration portal or presented in-person at the catchment school or school-of-choice:

PART ONE: Required documentation (does not have to be from British Columbia)

- 1. Photo identification for the parent/guardian such as: driver's licence, passport, Photo BC Services Card, BCID card.
- Evidence of guardianship (as shown on child's birth certificate, or other appropriate legal documentation, such as, landed immigrant document or guardianship order).
- Evidence of birth date for the student (e.g., birth certificate or passport).

PART TWO: Evidence of residence for the parent/guardian in British Columbia

4. Valid government issued documentation showing the address of residence with the name of ordinarily resident parent/guardian (e.g., BC Driver's License, BC Services Card, BCID or ICBC Registration Document, etc.). If the above documents are not available, the Principal uses discretion to register Students
