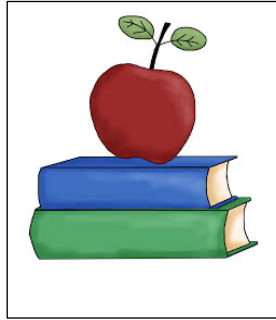

Dear Parents,

We hope you have all had a restful two months of summer with family and friends. As the 2022-2023 school year stretches

out ahead of us, we are excited to work together with you and the children to continue to support their learning!



Managing Health and Safety (H&S) This Year:

As we begin to leave pandemic worries behind, it is important to remember Schools are following the current guidelines of the Provincial Health Officer:

*Masks may be worn as a personal choice. If your child develops signs of illness while at school, a mask will be provided for them, to keep others from catching the illness.

*We will continue to wash hands a lot!

*Students and staff are asked to stay home when ill (including colds, flu, etc.)

COVID continues to be present, in new forms, and circulates in our community. Here are the measures that will keep us protected from its impacts, from most powerful (#1) to most basic (#4):

1. Get vaccinated. This is the most helpful defence against COVID! Get all boosters as they become available. This keeps your defences strong.
2. Spend time outdoors more than inside and clean all surfaces regularly
3. Give other people some space/distance
4. Limit contact with others, and wash hands often, as this reduces exposure to COVID.

*Thank you for helping to show your child how to be safe by continuing to model all of these safety measures at home, just as we will at school.

How do I stay up to date with information from the school?

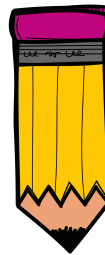
MJ Norris' Code of Conduct

The Student Planner is a helpful tool to assist in communicating between school and home. If your child's classroom teacher regularly uses a planner, a notice will go home asking you to purchase this item from the school. Planners cost \$5. The planner includes many very helpful pages about MJ Norris Elementary, such as routines and code of conduct, and calendar for the 2022-2023 year.

Student Forms

A package of student forms will be sent with your child very soon. ***These forms need to be reviewed each year and updated.*** These include the student information we have at the office, and media and nutrition permission forms. It is very important that these forms be read over, completed with current information, and returned to school as soon as possible once you have received them. Student Placements & Class Composition

Students met as a grade group today so that teachers could take attendance and give students information about the rest of the week.

This year, with many new students at the school, we will create the class groupings after our students and the teacher team for that grade level have worked on some back-to-school activities. Formal class lists will be made some time next week. Where a child may be placed in one of two classes, our promise to you is that no decision will be made hastily. Classes will be organized after careful consideration for the students' academic, social and emotional needs.

An increase or decrease in the enrollment can have a significant impact on these decisions, as a school may lose or gain a division. This process takes time. For the first week or so, all students at each grade level will work with each of the teachers at their grade level.



Student Absences

Kindly contact the school if your child will be absent or late. Each morning, when the attendance is reported to the office, our secretaries Ms. Oxley and Ms. Warne, will phone home if a child is absent if we haven't heard from you. We want to be sure each child is safe and hasn't gone missing en route to school.

Arrival and Departure

Students are to arrive between 8:20-8:30 and will be let into their exterior class doors at 8:30. Please be ready for your child to be dismissed at 2:30. All should have left the grounds by 2:45.



Allergy Alert!

It is very important that you inform the school of any allergies that your children have. This is especially the case if your child has a life-threatening allergy like anaphylaxis.

In the case of anaphylaxis, your child must have an EpiPen on them or at school and we want to ensure staff knows where their EpiPen is stored.

Martha Jane Norris Preschool & Before/After Care

The Cambridge Learning Centre, located in our school, provides a wonderful program for our preschool aged friends & a before and after school care program (for a fee). This is a private community group, and is not run by the school or district. Traffic Safety Reminder

This will improve our students' safety and health. For those of you living very far away, please drop the children off directly beside the sidewalk or on the drop off curb in the parking lot. Small children are so difficult to see in busy parking lots- they need to look both ways and stay with their adult.
