#### **Our Services:**



#### One-on-One Employment Counselling

We offer customized one-on-one support for newcomer job-seekers, including preemployment skills, resources, and volunteer opportunities to boost confidence and knowledge.



#### Job Search Skills Building

We review career options, tapping into hidden job markets, and developing a job search plan. We cover self-assessment, labor market exploration, career planning, resume writing, interview skills, and accessing resources for networking, volunteering, and training.



#### Career Mentorship

We connect newcomers with tailored mentors to provide support for Canadian career-path exploration, workplace cultures, and access to networks for a 3-month period.



## Meet the Employer

We facilitate networking events for small groups of newcomer job-seekers to meet employers who provide information on hiring processes and job opportunities.
