Treasury Report & Budget for 2022/2023 school year

- 2021/2022 Budget review presented by Vannie, motioned to approve as presented 1st: Melanie, 2nd: Manprit, and finalization is still in progress. Of note:
 - Outdoor class equipment went over budget for our new addition of school gardens as voted on and approved in previous meetings.
 - o Outdoor instruction over budget due to the \$1500 number being used simply as a placeholder for the line. This included the PAC funded portion of curling, gymnastics and hip-hop/Zumba.
 - Team uniforms/equipment over budget due to the purchase of new gym mats for gymnastics.
 Parents voted to approve use of the funds from the mural for the year to be used to purchase gym mats instead.
- 2022/2023 Budget presentation by Tabitha
 Discussion for the review of all lines in current budget proposal. Edits made and updated. Questions asked by Chair, None presented. Motion to approve by Tabitha, 1st: Ashley, 2nd: Melanie. As well we are hoping to add a couple small items to the playground which as reviewed in last meeting we realized are much more costly than first thought due to district requirements for ground updates prior to install."
