## 5. Fundraising Coordinator's Report

- PAC movie night Dec 1<sup>st</sup> (all kids). Movie TBD.
- Possible events discussed were Open Gym and Xmas Craft Fair
- Ideas for additional fundraisers discussed -Mabel Labels (20% comes back), Jars by Jody (40% comes back), Fundscrip-gift card fundraiser (PAC gets a % back depending on the vendor/business), Big Brother spring cleaning-\$2.50 per bag. Only household goods and clothing, no furniture.

### 6. Chair's Report

- Motion to give \$2700 from the gaming funds to teacher/classroom funds (11 divisions-\$200 per class plus \$500 non enrolling). Motion to accept by Fatima, seconded by Hailey. All in favour, motion carried.

- For the upcoming fundraisers, to check if there is an option to add 'donate' on munch a lunch.
