Board Policy

SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 36 (SURREY) No. 9320 POLICY: REGISTRATION AND PLACEMENT OF STUDENTS

The Board values the "neighbourhood school" (defined as the school catchment area) and strives to maintain the integrity of student placement in neighbourhood schools.

At the same time, the district reserves the right to restrict and redirect student placement in a manner which limits inefficiencies in the use of space, resources and educational programs.

Students may seek to attend a school outside their catchment area under the conditions outlined in the Regulations and subject to district limitations on capacity.

Board Policy



POLICY #9200 SCHOOL CATCHMENT AREAS

It is the responsibility of the secretary-treasurer to ensure that school catchment areas are established for neighbourhood schools.

The following principles should apply when establishing catchment areas:

- 1. Boundaries are created to regulate enrolment at schools to maximize the costeffective use of the space.
- 2. Boundaries are determined such that enrolment in any school is optimized.
- 3. Boundaries are established to minimize the amount of bussing required.
- 4. Boundaries are created in the interest of student safety using arterial roads and natural boundaries to form catchment areas whenever possible.
- 5. Boundaries should be created that minimize the need for capital funds.

School catchment boundaries for district and community-initiated programs (programs of choice) will be considered district-wide and not site specific. Programs of choice will be offered only in space surplus to the needs of the neighbourhood school program or in space leased for a specific program need.




Option 1: Move the Montessori Program from Latimer Road to Strawberry Hill beginning in September 2024. The program would be dependent on sufficient enrolment.

Option 2 (Recommended): Students currently in the Montessori Program at Latimer Road finish the program there. New Kindergarten requests enter the lottery process for the Montessori Program at Douglas Elementary or Mountainview Montessori. Expand the Montessori program at Mountainview Montessori.

Option 3: Offer a new Montessori program for children in Kindergarten at Strawberry Hill. The program would be dependent on sufficient enrolment. Students currently in the program finish the program at Latimer Road.

- Strawberry Hill Elementary was chosen because it has seven empty classrooms.
