Dear Parents/Guardians:

This newsletter will provide you with some important information as well as upcoming events during the month of December.

Parents coming into the school <u>must</u> check in at the office to sign in and get a Visitor Badge. There are no **exceptions**. All staff must wear Identification Badges and we require any visitors to also wear badges. This is for everyone's safety and to ensure classroom instruction is not interrupted. Please <u>do not go straight</u> to your child's classroom without checking in at the office and without a visitor badge.

**Staff Parking lot** – Thank you to all of our parents for following our parking lot guidelines. This helps in keeping all of our students and staff safe as well as making sure our staff have a place to park their cars. The parking is only for staff members. Please continue to park along the streets if you are driving your children to school. There is **no parent parking in the parking lot**, except for those who have children with mobility concerns. Walking your children to school is always a great way to get exercise, get fresh air, and spend that time with your kids.

Getting to school on time – **All students need to be at school between 8:20am – 8:30am**. There is no supervision outside until **8:20am** so please do not drop off your children before that time. Remember being late to start school affects your child's learning and confidence, and does not set a positive example of an important life skill.



**Reporting attendance** – If your child is going to be absent, please continue to call the school and **press 1** to reach the automated system to leave a message there. You can also e-mail the office at hjorthroadabsentee@surreyschools.ca.

**Communicating Student Learning**: Report cards will be coming home on **December 20<sup>th</sup>**. It is very important that all parents are reading them through and discussing with their children. Some classroom teachers are using the digital format called Spaces. Spaces is an ongoing portfolio that parents are expected to go through regularly. Teachers put in a lot of time to add information onto Spaces, so I just want to remind parents about this. If you are unsure, please contact the classroom teacher.

Parent Advisory Committee (PAC) – We will have a PAC meeting next week on Thursday Dec. 7<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm in our school library. All parents are welcome. Remember, all parents that have children in the school, automatically become a member of the PAC. We will need to get some people to volunteer for the Positions to form the Executive. A newsletter was sent out yesterday via email to provide detailed information about PAC.

We will be going outside at Recess and Lunch! Our West Coast weather has arrived and with it comes the reminder to all families to ensure that students are dressed for outside play.
