What is StrongStart?

StrongStart programs provide rich learning environments designed to support children’s early development across all areas – linguistic, physical, cognitive, social and emotional well being. Qualified Early Childhood Educators (ECEs) create safe, inclusive environments where children find opportunities to participate, think, explore and discover new things about themselves, others and the world around them. As children attend StrongStart with family members, the ECE also provides support to all caregivers, sharing parenting resources, tools to create joyful learning at home, help in identifying a child’s extra support needs, and assistance to access community resources. At StrongStart we work together to celebrate and nurture every child’s gifts.

How do I register for StrongStart?

Before you click the registration link you will need to know the following information:

1. Name of StrongStart location you would like to attend. To see all Surrey locations [click here](#)
2. Important Identification documents ready to upload. To see identification needed [click here](#).
3. The registration form is the same as if you were registering your child for school but you register specifically for a ‘StrongStart Centre’ location rather than a school.

At what age can I start to bring my child to a StrongStart?

StrongStart is open to all children along with their caregiver from birth until age five (or when they enter Kindergarten)

When can we start to attend?

Registrations are received and processed by the StrongStart Educator at each site. They make every effort to process registrations as quickly as possible and reach out to each family for times to start. During busy times like September/October, January and March/April it can take up to two weeks.

What is the difference between StrongStart and Pre-school?

In preschool programs the child attends independently, without the caregiver. Pre-schools vary in philosophies and approach to children's learning and development. StrongStart requires a caregiver to attend with the child. It is rooted in a play-based learning philosophy that follows the [BC Early Learning Framework](#)

Does StrongStart run all year long?
