Introductions

Principal's Message –Phil and Kristy

- 2 fine arts performances: Dumpster Dragons and Ache Brasil, the cost of the 2 together \$1900
- Kiln: 4 steps. We have a spot for it.
- Vaisakhi, thank you for the samosas and the tea
- Assembly tomorrow: dancing, grade 7's will share the story of Vaisakhi
- Technology has arrived for Salmon Pod
 - o Primary classes now have 6 iPads/class; Intermediate have 8 iPads + keyboards, 1 laptop; and all classes have charging stations
 - o PAC has contributed \$19,000 to technology upgrades and purchases this year
- Gaming Grant: roughly \$10,000. Must fall within the guidelines
- The rest of the money will depend on how much we fundraise.
- Band: mandatory band next year for the grade 7's. This was well received by PAC meeting attendees.

Diversity Club Presentation- Julina Murphy (PAE teacher)

- Rainbow cross walk (city quoted \$17,000)
- Ernie Klassen White Rock City Council: they would like to fundraise during pride month and help raise money for this crosswalk. They are estimating (speculating to fundraise ~\$7500). The City will pay half \$8500.
- That leaves around \$1000 to request from PAC. Will see if we can also use the gaming funds (however, it's not on school property)
- Can we use school funds? Must be careful because it's not on school property. No
- Can they have 1 or 2 presenters from the pride society to come and talk to the PAC? Yes

- The technology presentation (which was supposed to be put on by South Meridian PAC) has been cancelled. We will look into the presentation in the fall.
