4. Principal's message:

- Brad displayed the new jersey and thanked PAC for their kind donation.

5. Financials:

- As of today we have \$13,601.26 in the Regular Account and \$31,524.85 in the Gaming Account.
 - We are still waiting for the jerseys cheque to clear from the Gaming Account.
 - \$9,000 will also be coming out from the Gaming Account for the Hip Hop.
- We budgeted \$4,000 for the Christmas 2023 Gringe and Pancakes but we didn't do the pancakes.
 - We had money left over as the cost for the Gringe was \$500 + \$311 for the candies.
 - PAC agreed to allocate that money towards the school library (\$750 for the labels and \$1,500 towards the books).
 - o All in favour PAC passed it.
- We will drop the PAC domain name emails and use generic email as the costs have gone up.
 - o All in favour PAC passed it.

6. Hot Lunches:

- Promote "Feed an Eagle" fund (winter 2024 \$33, fall 2023 \$100)
 - Allows parents to donate for families in assistance.
- PAC funding lunches for families in need of assistance (to date \$294.50)
 - $\circ \quad \text{Jenny determines which families need the assistance.} \\$

- Andrea Phillips suggested to provide \$50 to each student (need of assistance) to use towards lunch and end when \$50 is used.
- PAC will continue funding for the hot lunch and determine the following school calendar year.
- No more concession sales on lunch days.

7. Fundraisers:

- Purdy's chocolate fundraising doubled from last year as we sent out hard copies out to families.
 - Purdy's profit \$895.45
- Kernels profit \$346.60
- Upcoming:
 - o Raffle in April.
 - Only teachers can sign out the tickets.
 - Hold the money and tickets at the office in a separate pouch.
 - Angela Skillen will pick up every day.
 - 2 ½ weeks of selling raffle tickets.
 - Purdy's Easter in February and pick on March 11^{th.}
 - TCBY fundraisers to sell tube of yogurt in June.
 - Kernels
 - Freezie Friday's
 - o Doughnuts sell online and have vendor at school to distribute (more discussion later).

8. Old Business:
