

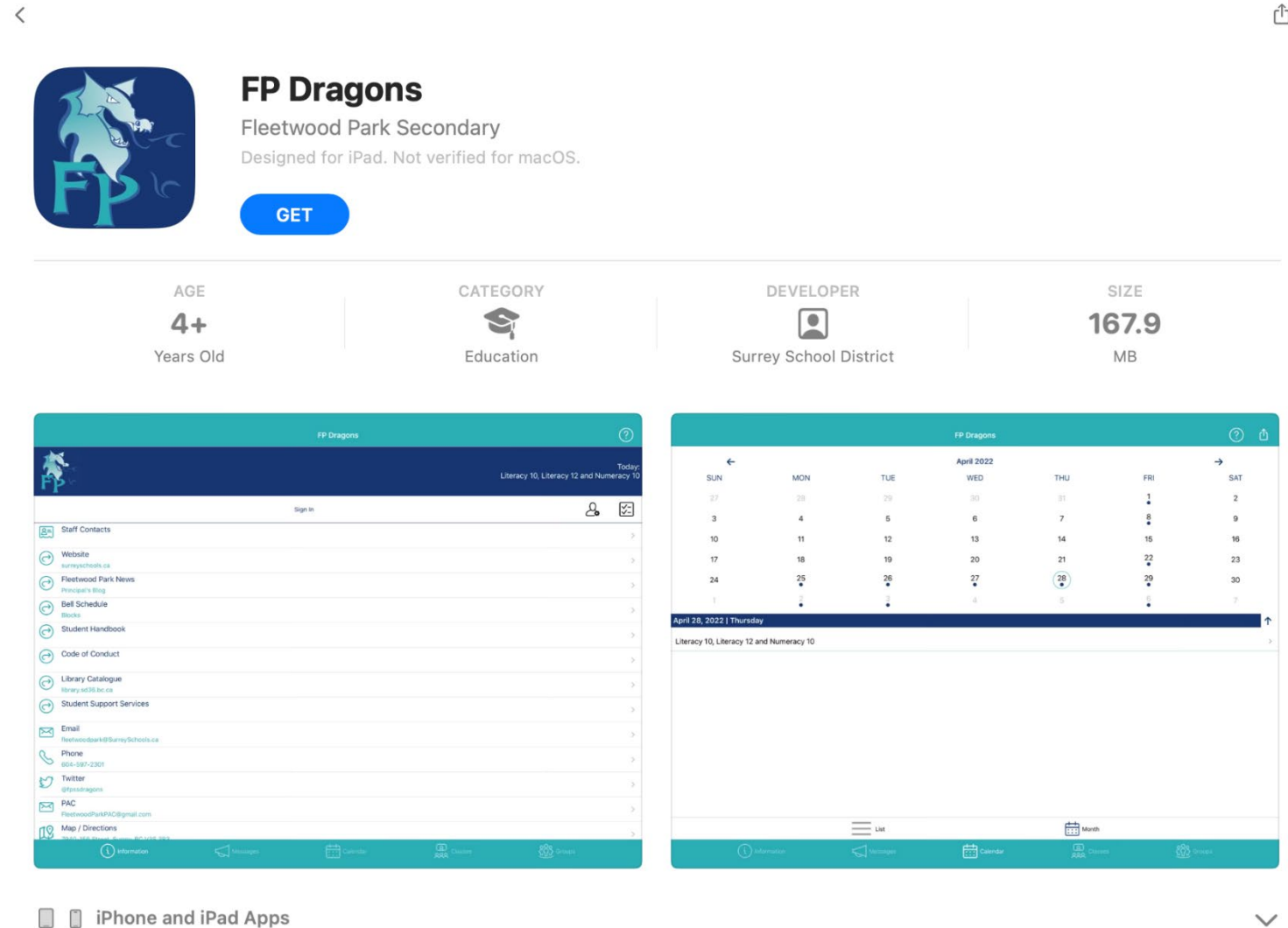


MyEd BC
