

BC Excellence Scholarship
Application for School Nomination

Each school is entitled to nominate one applicant.

No Open Applications are permitted.

The BC Excellence Scholarship is a \$5000 scholarship that recognizes students that:

- ***Have demonstrated community service and leadership, both inside and outside of their schools,***
- ***Have shown a commitment to and an aptitude for their chosen career paths,***
- ***Exemplify the competencies as identified in BC's curriculum***

There is no specified format required for your application for the school's nomination for this scholarship. However, you must provide the Scholarship Committee with:

- a. Information that is responsive to Section 3 of the application,
- b. A description of the nature of the information that you believe your reference will be able to confirm the information indicated in Section 4 of the application and why she or he is in a position to provide that information,
- c. An outline of the approach that you expect to take in responding to Section 5 of the application.
- d. A copy of a current marks printout (Diploma Verification Report). This should be available from your counsellor. It does not need to be an 'official' document.

The basic criterion to receive the nomination is that you must satisfy the School Scholarship Committee and Mr. Cross that you are the candidate that has the highest probability of being successful in the competition for one of the available scholarships.

Due Date:

- **All application for the school's nomination must be received by Mr. Maion around the end of November/beginning of December. Applicants must check updated announcements.**
- The applications will be reviewed and a decision made by early January.
- The fully completed application must be submitted to the Ministry of Education by mid-February. Applicants must follow up with changes in deadlines.
