

DISTRICT AUTHORITY AWARDS

Every year each high school in the Surrey gets a number of \$1,250 District Authority Awards from the Ministry of Education. These are awards for mostly non-academic areas that students may excel in. This year **Johnston Heights has been awarded 31 scholarships!**

There are **seven categories** that can be applied for:

1. **Applied Design/Skills/Technology** – for Business, Home Economics, Media, Technology, Tourism
2. **Community Service**
3. **Fine Arts** – for Dance, Theatre, Visual Arts, Music
4. **Indigenous Language & Culture**
5. **Languages**
6. **Physical Activity & Health** – for Athletics (in & out of school), Dance, Gym
7. **Technical & Trades Training** – for Coding, Culinary Arts, Mechanics, Robotics, Woodwork, etc.

THINGS TO KNOW:

- You must be a Canadian citizen or Landed Immigrant/Permanent Resident
- You can apply for several but can only win one
- You have five years to redeem/use it; it can only be used for post-secondary education and/or training

WHAT AND HOW TO SUBMIT:

- You must provide *evidence* of your excellence in the chosen category (eg. pictures of your involvement, awards, recognition, letters of reference, projects, report cards, etc.).
- This must be all *presented in a contained format/“portfolio”* (ie. duotang, folder with contents together, USB stick, website, etc.)
- You need to *include the attached sheets (pages 2 & 3 only)* as the first two pages of your “portfolio”.
- Failure to follow all instructions, submission of unoriginal, “paraphrased”, uncited and/or incorrectly cited work submitted and late submissions will automatically disqualify your application(s).

DEADLINE: Must be submitted to Ms. Domingo no later than Monday, April 24th at 3:00 PM. NO EXCEPTIONS!
