a. (E.g. Partnership, Coop & Apprenticeship Programs, Carpentry, Automotive, Chef Training/Culinary Arts, Robotics, Coding)

6. COMMUNITY SERVICE

a. (E.g. Evidence of volunteer activity, pictures, awards and letters of reference), which includes awareness of local, global, and cultural issues.

7. INDIGENOUS LANGUAGES & CULTURE

a. Demonstrated at school or in the community
