## STUDENT PARKING INFORMATION & REGULATIONS

Students bringing cars to school are **required to park in the <u>student parking lot</u>**. Students' cars must <u>not</u> be parked in the **fire lane, bus bay**, the **visitor's parking area**, or **reserved stalls**. The following regulations apply to the use of the parking lot:

- 1. All vehicles, including motorcycles, must be registered at the office.
- 2. A student who wishes to drive more than one vehicle to school must register each vehicle at the office.
- 3. The school is <u>not responsible</u> for any vandalism or damage incurred to any vehicle while on school property, nor for anything lost or stolen from vehicles. Please <u>lock your vehicle</u> and <u>keep all valuables out of sight</u>.
- 4. Drivers and passengers <u>must wear seat belts at ALL times</u>. It is the *responsibility of the driver* to make sure that any passenger is wearing his or her seat belt while in the vehicle. Failure to do so will result in a suspension of the parking permit. No vehicle is permitted to carry more occupants than the number of seat belts in that vehicle.
- 5. New drivers (i.e. drivers who must display an "N") may not carry more than one passenger (unless it is a family member).
- 6. Parking privileges will be revoked if:
  - a. The student speeds on any street in the vicinity of the school or in the parking lot. <u>THE SPEED LIMIT IN THE PARKING IS 8 (EIGHT) KM/H</u>. The speed limit on <u>public streets in the vicinity of the school is 30 km/h</u>.
  - b. The student **engages in any unacceptable behaviors** including:
    - 1. Parking in such a manner that the vehicle occupies more than one parking stall. No part of the parked car should cross over any white border line of a parking stall.
    - 2. The student plays loud music, either in the parking lot or on the streets in the vicinity of the school. An acceptable volume is one in which a normal conversation could be held over the music.
    - 3. The student accelerates at such a rate as to cause the driving wheels to spin on the pavement (this is generally referred to as "burning out").
    - 4. Any reckless, careless, or dangerous driving.
    - 5. A student (driver or passenger) litters.
    - 6. A student loiters in the parking lot. Students are not permitted to sit in cars in the parking lot before, during, or after school, or during lunch.
    - 7. An occupant in the vehicle fails to wear his or her seatbelt at any time. Drivers must wear their seatbelts AND ensure that all passengers inside the car wear their seatbelts. If a passenger does not wear his or her seatbelt, the parking privileges of the DRIVER will be revoked.
    - 8. The driver is not clearly displaying his or her "N" (to designate "new driver" status) when the car is in motion, either in the parking lot or on streets in the vicinity of the school.
    - 9. Rudeness or anything less than immediate and courteous cooperation with any staff member.
  - c. A student has withdrawn from school.
  - d. A student violates any regulations stated in the Motor Vehicle Act. If the vehicle is seen driven in an unsafe manner by any person in the vicinity of the school, the parking privileges of the student will be revoked.
