Enrollment... Currently NSS has 1415 students, 2019/20 is projected to drop to 1399 students and by 2020/21 enrollment is projected to go up to 1449 students with current real estate growth in the area.

Athletic teams & Clubs...Upcoming information on sports teams/tryouts and various school clubs are done with daily announcements and posted on the TV screens throughout the school every day.

Crosswalk Safety...Student safety is still a concern while they are crossing at the crosswalk. Educating students on crosswalk safety is still a priority within the school – ensuring students are aware of their surroundings and making visual eye contact with drivers while using the crosswalk.

Report cards... are available on My Ed BC portal. There will be no printed report cards sent home with students. The report cards will only be available to view until the next report card is uploaded to My ED. Each student's report cards should be downloaded to keep on file. *The end of year report card is only available for 3 weeks until the next school calendar year begins.

Art Project...during First Nations week students/speakers will be working on an art project that will become a lasting legacy in NSS. This will be displayed within the school.

Department Goals...Overall NSS has been working towards student engagement. The goal was refined to specific goals to improve engagement and evidence of achievement.

Robotics Club...presented to PAC the achievements they have accomplished in their 3 years of building. They have been awarded numerous team and individual awards. They have also go out into the community to build awareness of Girls in STEM and FIRST Robitics.
