Learning Support BASES (LSB) Course Outline

Building Academic, Social and Employment Skills (Grades 8-12)

The Learning Support BASES team would like to welcome you to Panorama Ridge Secondary. The LSB course provides academic and social support throughout the year. Students will learn and develop study skills, emotional regulation strategies, functional skills, and essential work skills.

As a member of the LSB Room you will receive:

- Assistance with homework/studying for tests
- A space to write tests from other courses (with advance notice)
- A voice in your Individual Education Plan (IEP)
- Outings and activities related to everyday living



LSB is comprised of four areas. However, every student's learning will be shaped by their individual goals.

Literacy

- Communication skills (reading, writing, listening, speaking)
- Reading various texts (novels, articles, charts, directions, recipes, health information)

Numeracy

- Functional skills (counting, calculations, operations, measuring)
- Practical money math (making change, sale units/price, percentage discounts)
- Reading clocks and managing time
- Personal finances

Personal and Social Skills

- Self-advocacy
- Organization and time-management strategies
- Decision-making/Problem solving
- Identifying, Understanding, Expressing & Regulating Emotions
- Maintaining friendships
- Personal and Community Safety

Career and Employment Skills

- Work Experience opportunities
- Resumes and cover letters
- Interview skills

- Job research and applications
- WorkSafe skills

Evaluation

Students will be graded using the Proficiency Scale and evaluated on their progress in their unique IEP goals.
