

The Leisure Access Program provides the following benefits to those who qualify and enrol:

- One-year Full Facility pass for family members 18 years and younger or 60 years and older.
- 75% discount on most registered courses. Maximum discount per program year is as follows: \$300 (\$400.00 retail) per family member 18 years and younger \$150 (\$200.00 retail) per family member 19 years and older
- 75% discount on single admissions or monthly/yearly passes for adults 19-59 years.
