SPECIAL GUEST REPORT

Ms. Chen is requesting some additional funding towards the "Safe Teen" Program, they are grateful for the \$2K already provided to this program.

The Safe Teen program is offered to Grade 9 Students who are divided into groups of 30, by the gender they identify with, to meet with trained "Safe Teen" Facilitators - they need 12 Safe Teen classes this year.

Topics for the youth include:

 Understanding and responding to bullying / harassment / healthy relationships / dealing with / cyber bulling / self protection/ knowing boundaries and respectfully dealing with conflict

The School team reports that there have been some challenges with the Grade 9 class this year, and due to Covid, some of these important life skills would be very valuable to the students at the school this year.

TREASURER REPORT

The PAC has 3 sources of Revenues that we are responsible for:

- Community Gaming Funds: Funded each year based on the head count; generally around \$20/head, we received \$47K this year from the Community Gaming Funds, but received over 64K worth of requests, so a committee was struck and had to make some difficult decisions on how the money would be disbursed. Current gaming balance: \$39,562
- 2. <u>PAC (Legacy in trust at District):</u> Legacy funds held at the district we draw down on these funds as required for special requests, once these funds are gone, the account will close. This account may be used for special requests that are not allowed to be used by gaming funds. Current Balance: \$4450



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- 3. <u>Sullivan PAC:</u> Funded generally from parent contributions we send out a request annually for a \$20 donation from parents to add to the pool of resources. Current balance: \$4548
- 4. <u>Dry Grad Account:</u> Has approx \$9716 to start for this year solely for Dry Grad activities.
