1. **A paragraph explaining why you are the most deserving candidate for Valedictorian. (250-300 words)**
    - This is what you will be expected to present to both the grad class and the staff voting committee before voting.
  2. **A condensed version (350-500 words) of what ultimately would be expanded to be your Valedictorian speech.**
    - Members of the Valedictorian selection committee will receive a copy of this for review and consideration.
  3. **The academic standing/extra-curriculars data forms (both A and B)**
    - All information provided will be reviewed by the Vetting Panel
    - Members of the Valedictorian selection committee will receive copies for review and consideration.
  4. **The Sullivan Heights staff member reference form**

6. April 19<sup>th</sup> at 3:30pm - Application deadline: submit applications to the school office.

8. May 6<sup>th</sup> – May 9<sup>th</sup> at lunch in Room C209 – **Selected Candidates** to present condensed speech to selection committee.
9. May 21<sup>st</sup> in the theatre – **Final Candidates** to present “deserving candidate” speech in the Grade 12 assembly. Voting takes place at the Grade 12 assembly. Each Grade 12 in attendance receives a ballot.


