- 5. Request from Department Heads for Gaming Funds
 - Request from Social Studies for nationally renowned Editorial Cartoonist to discuss editorial cartoons and decoding for \$900 for Grade 10 students <u>approved</u>
 - Request from Social Studies for hands-on Yukon Gold Rush experience for \$2,248 for Grade 9 students <u>approved</u>
 - Request for Scholarship and Bursary presentation for Grades 11 and 12 students for \$420 approved
 - Request from Yearbook Club for 6 DSLR 500+ cameras and lenses at approximately \$700 to \$900 each for an approximate total of \$4,000 <u>tentatively approved</u> with certain stipulations; source cameras with better technology than current DSLR (consider mirrorless) and possibly at higher quantities and provide feedback prior to purchase
- 6. Dry Grad
 - Mr. De Boice will meet with Parent-led Dry Grad committee
 - Kayaks family Halloween House fundraiser raised \$193.85 for Dry Grad
- 7. Principal's Report (Kevin De Boice)
 - Mr. De Boice is Director of Secondary School Principals
 - Across the board schools have found that Grade 8 students have had a challenging time acclimating to attending Secondary School due to COVID
 - District-wide there are issues with LST (Learner Support Team) teaching support due to funding and allocation of hours
 - In the 2020/2021 school year Tamanawis and Panorama Ridge had a high number of COVID cases and thus far Tamanawis has only had two exposure events
