  - Reviewed fundraising activities from last year
  - Reviewed costs and events
  - Appeal to parents to volunteer and get involved with Dry Grad 2022-2023
- 7. Dry Grad Committee 2022-2023
  - PAC provides \$5,000 to Dry Grad Committee
  - Dry Grad Committee commits to fundraising \$5,000 to return these funds back to PAC
  - Committee for 2022-2023 Dry Grad requires the following positions: Chair (reports to PAC Chair), Co-Chair, Secretary, Treasurer, Fundraising Coordinator
  - Roman nominates Shante for Chair, seconded by Shabiha accepted by Shante

  - Sharleen nominates Valen for Co-Chair, seconded by Harjeet accepted by Valen
  - Shante nominates Roman for Secretary, seconded by Shabiha accepted by Roman
  - Valen nominates Sharleen and Harjeet for Fundraising Coordinators, seconded by Shante – accepted by Sharleen and Harjeet
  - Votes duly conducted for all nominations, all in favour of each, motions carried
- 8. Student Grad Committee
  - Over the summer some of the graduates discussed how they want the event to be and are very enthusiastic
  - First Grad Committee meeting is Friday September 16 at lunch with Mrs. Krawchuk
- 9. Principal's Report
  - Mr. De Boice has been in the district since 1985 and has held many positions in schools and at the Board Office
  - Currently Director of Secondary Principals
  - Notes that all schools are great, but that Tamanawis is a leader in three, key areas:
    - Number of clubs (ranked highest in the district)
    - Quarterly reports on fights (ranked 19, 20 or 21)
    - Dollars spent due to vandalism (ranked 20 or 21)
  - Tamanawis will receive a \$50 million expansion in the very near future
