### 4. Principal's Report (James Johnston)

• Good to see announcement from government about cellphone use within schools. Cellphone motels, a third of staff are using this method so far, encouraging more

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discussion between teachers to use.

- Dealing with issues regarding washroom usage. Boys' bathroom in particular on the South side, locking the door intermittently to prevent long visits.
- "Significant 72', the first 72 seconds, minutes, days to get to know students.
- Working to create better spaces for students to gather.
- February is Black History Month- All students identify, most teachers don't. Good conversations about traditions and views within families.
- Tamanawis Rocks, Theatre students, gr.7 students being invited to introduce and welcome to school.
- Basketball playoffs going
- Students are excited for dances
- Enrollment, 3-4 applications per week, working to create more spaces, possibly look into online options for senior students. Divide larger classrooms, use al spaces available to create spaces. There will not be any more portables, will be a while before expansion.
- Vape detectors still not installed, parent inquiry. Stuck in finance, follow up was a month ago.
