8. Old Business

School Uniforms;

- A few parents have expressed interest in introducing school uniforms.
- If there is a *strong* interest, a meeting would be called to discuss the next steps.
 - Example; if 20% of voting members expressed interest (approximately 300 parents/guardians) this would <u>not</u> be considered strong enough support.
- Surrey School District 36 uniform programs are <u>not</u> mandatory if a uniform is adopted in the future, wearing the uniform would be optional

9. New Business

- Request for Gaming Funds Ms. Goto, bus transportation for Grade 8 Band students, \$1570. Motion approved.
- BC Student Learning Survey 2024- Parents are encouraged to fill out online, 1 survey per child.
- Extended Day Letter has gone out. Hoping to know more by next PAC meeting, planning is in the works. There will still be one shared lunch hour, not 2 separate lunch hours.
- PAC Accounts Signing Authorities in order to follow our constitution, we need to make adjustments to have 3 PAC Executives, Treasurer as 1 of them, as signing authority for After Grad account, will make the changes at the end of the school year to make easier transition. Asking PAC executive Co-chair Mandy as signing authority until September. Then we will switch to full PAC Executives.
 - After Grad treasurer requesting a change in constitution to prevent multiple signing authorities, thus having all accounts with one banking institution. Each year the signing authorities would deal with accounts to prevent multiple change-over, keeps account names consistent and posted online for transparency.
 - Intent is to have all PAC-related accounts (including the After Grad account) at one institution and the PAC Executive will have signing authority for all
