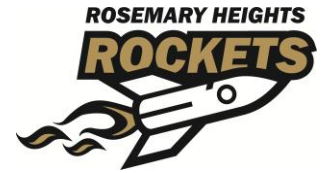

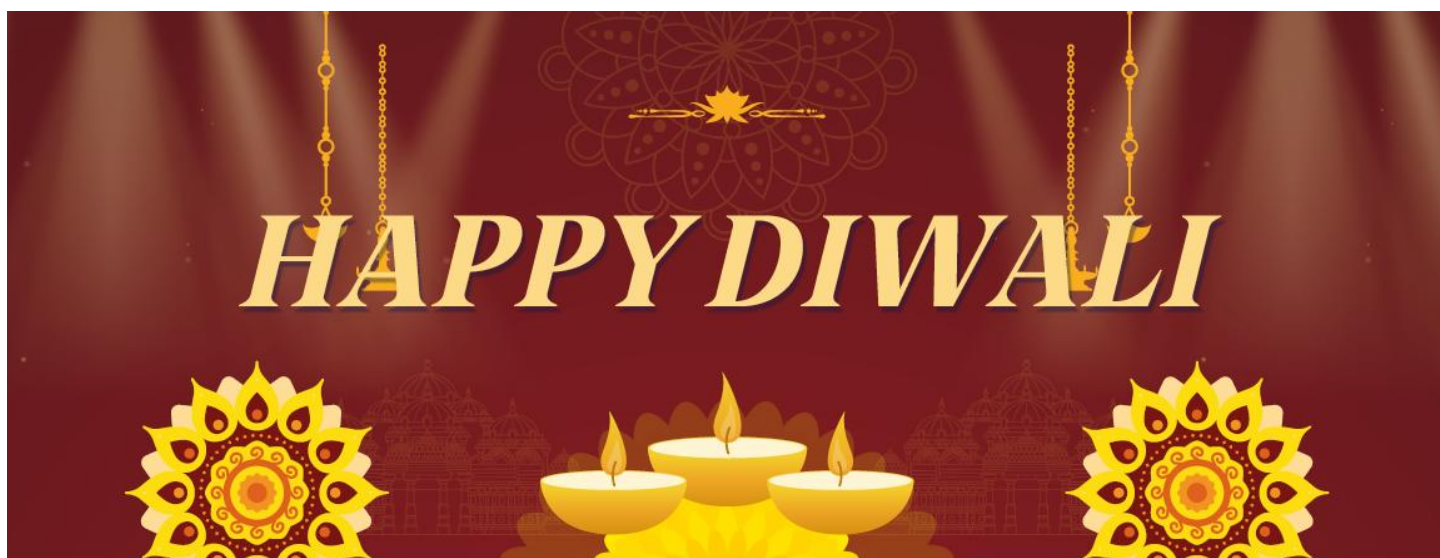

STAY SAFE - GRADES 4 & 5

Building on an increasing maturity level, this course empowers children with the tools to build confidence and reliability to stay safe while alone for short periods of time.
