

- ► End of August:
- schedules available online
- Early September:
- ▶ NO CHANGES, except:
- empty block
- summer school completion
- missing grad requirements.



Grad Requirements:

- **80 Credits** (20 courses x 4 credits = 80 credits)
 - MANDATORY:
 - English 10, 11, 12
 a Math 10 and 11
 - ► PE 10 a Science 11
 - ► Social Studies 10 & 12 CLC 12
 - ▶ CLE 10
 - 4 Grade 12 courses (English 12 + 3 more)
 - **1 Fine Arts or Applied Skills course in Grades 10. 11 or 12
- NEW & MANDATORY:
- 1 First Peoples course (4 credits)



- When you are in Grade 11 or 12, you attend this program off site for one semester and get post secondary credits PLUS high school credits.
- ► A "C" or better in English 10 and Math 10 are minimum requirements.
- Attendance records are very important to qualify for these programs

WHAT DO I NEED TO APPLY TO POST-SECONDARY?

COLLEGE REQUIREMENTS

- > ENGLISH 12 or English First People's 12 is the only course needed for <u>general</u> admission.
 - Kwantlen requires a minimum grade of 67% (C+)
 - Douglas College requires a minimum grade of 60% (C)
 - Langara College requires either a 50% or a 70% in English 12 depending on program.
- There are also <u>program specific requirements</u> especially Math requirements. Find out what you need!
