Panago Pizza - we had 4 pizzas out of 16 pizzas left over. PAC didn't like how Panago pizza slices were not equal pieces and was a bit overpriced for the event. We had a few parents approach PAC Execs over Facebook saying that their kids do not like the Panagos pizzas and never eats it. PAC has sourced out a couple local halal pizza places for our next event and hot lunches.

We had a variety of sodas and found that Regular Coca Cola and Orange Fanta were very popular than Diet Coke, Coke Zero, Sprite, Ginger Ale, Fresca, Iced Tea, and Pineapple Fresca. Bottled water did not sell many.

Popcorn Machine was a hit, and a nice investment for special events at the school, we bought 4 bags of popcorn kernels and used all of them and all the popcorn was sold out at movie night.

Cotton Candy (Strawberry, Blue Raspberry, Green Apple and Grape Flavor) were very popular, we sold half of the quantity at the movie night, and we only have a few left over after the afterschool sale.

Halal-Friendly Candy bags (Gelatin Free) lots left over, large bags sold out and lots of small bags left over.

Chip bags, we bought 4 boxes for the combos and to sell at the concession, we have lots left over

PAC Concession – We will be selling concession at the Canteen Window **Food Trucks** - Meet2Eat food truck (Mexican) and Kona Ice has applied to be at the event. We are currently working on the document process.

Advertising - Wai has designed and ordered a 3ftx2ft banner and 10 lawn signs to place around the community. We made the design generic so we can reuse the banners for future markets. (Cost \$200)
