

Hooked on Book Home Reading Program



Dear Parent/Guardian.

Creekside Elementary is starting a home reading program called "Hooked on Books" on Tuesday October 1st, 2024. It is a reading program designed to increase excitement in reading, lower student stress levels, and grow their vocabulary and knowledge. Reading at home not only allows students to enjoy a variety of texts throughout the school year but it can also be an opportunity for students to share and discuss what they are reading with their family and friends.

For this program:

- Students are asked to read daily for a minimum of 20 minutes per day.
- Parents/Guardians are asked to sign or initial the "25 nights of reading" handout for each night their child reads for at least 20 minutes.
- You can only fill out one slot per night. If you read 3 books in one night that's excellent but it doesn't count.
- Your child is encouraged to read to themselves, you, another family member, or an interested friend.
- Students can read books that are assigned by teachers, checked out from school or public libraries, their own books, magazines, newspapers, or even ebooks or tumble books.

Students will bring their signed handouts to the library after they have read for 25 nights and will be entered into a monthly prize draw at the beginning of the following month. Once students have handed in their handout they can pick up a "50 nights of reading" form. Reach 200 nights of reading by the end of the year and receive a special prize!
