-cross walk safety is a concern; parents are asked to adopt safer driving habits in school zones and be extra mindful during drop off and pick up. Unsafe driving includes: making u-turns, putting on hazards, parking in the middle of the road as well as blocking pathways and not yielding to pedestrians

-Reminder that children's safety is the main concern! you can report unsafe driving by calling the police non-emergency line; discussed implementing a "Walk to School" challenge (this has seen success at other schools especially in warmer weather)

-Revive First Aid (a partner of the Red Cross) may be scheduled to offer babysitting and stay safe courses in the upcoming year (likely during a Pro D day) and will be offered to students at cost, more details to follow if there is enough interest
