**7:17-7:34 PM – Treasurer Report (Tara)**

- Multicultural events (LNY) – usually \$1000 given, but the LNY committee raised over \$2000 so over \$1000 in profit
- Wish list items which could come from our 10,000 funding for the year - \$7000 available
- Mural for gym proposed
- Gaga ball
- \$5000 tech allotted for every year instead of \$10,000 every 2<sup>nd</sup> year. Definitely some tech that needs to be replaced.
- More jerseys in bigger sizes (adult medium/large)
- Outdoor learning – someone retired so therefore the project has been delayed
- Planetarium and futsal and rollerblading planned or have taken place already with pac funds this year
- Fundraiser – valentines sale we have made \$600
- Hot lunch organized but losing money on extras that aren't being sold
- Only certain vendors do well selling the extras
- Much easier to distribute lunches with only vendor food and no additions
- Will reassess after April to see if the two days a week has been profitable

#### **7:35-8:17 PM – Upcoming/Current/Open Forum**

- Sports day – proposed blow up costumes for teacher race
- School ranking has decreased and parents wondering why this has changed. FSA was previously opt out, now it is not optional. Testing for end of curriculum but given earlier in the year. Very skewed and too many variables
- FSA has a guided instruction for teachers
- Proposed to the school to send out some information about FSA's and to bring understanding about how the FSA's are not reflective of the quality of the school.
- Fundraiser magic show – maximum occupancy under 500, show is 1 hr, open door at 530 April 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday. Sell concession, etc. charge for tickets for children and adults. Can sell magic kits and would get 25%. We will not sell kits.
- Raffle should make 10,000 – may not do, silent auction for grade 7 grad. Raffle could be online so will be a little easier. Will need a gaming license but will need 8-10 weeks to receive so will need to set up ASAP.
- Some options for upcoming fundraisers: Munchie Monday, Frozen yogurt – end of day treat, crazy bread day, reflectors for backpacks and coats, hot dog day
- Need executive roles for next year – pac members will ask around and also add to newsletters
