Treasurer Responsibilities:

- Be a signing officer
- Ensure all funds of the council are properly accounted for
- Disburse funds as authorized by the membership or executive
- Ensure that proper financial records and books of account are maintained
- Report on all receipts and disbursements at general and executive meetings
- Make financial records and books of account available to members upon request
- Have the financial records and books of accounts ready for inspection or audit annually
- With the assistance of the executive, draft an annual budget
- Ensure that another signing officer has access to the financial records and books of account in the treasurer's absence
- Submit an annual financial statement at the annual general meeting

Presidents Report

Budget 2025-2026

PAC Executive is responsible for the money held on behalf of parents. Our funds belong to the membership as a whole and does not belong to the executive, treasurer, school or school district. The executive and treasurer may spend council money only with authority of the membership and in accordance with the council's bylaws.

The PAC has its own bank accounts - Gaming and Main Account. All banking services are provided by Vancity Credit Union and statements are emailed to the PAC email address and the schools address is used on all accounts. The treasurer is responsible for ensuring safe custody of the money which includes checks, deposit books, preparing reconciliation, regular reports and drafting a budget with executive support. The following budget has been proposed and will be discussed at our next PAC meeting - see next page.

Prior to any spending to occur for this new school year, the PAC will be presenting the following budget at the September 29 PAC meeting for members to approve. An agenda and full budget will be circulated Please ensure you are on our mailing list. As of September 15, 2025, we have the following amounts in our PAC Accounts:

Playground Account: \$2,119.26 Gaming Account: \$3,848.53 Main Account: \$23,284.31

We are requesting the following items and amount be approved:

- Education Presentation and Programs \$2,000
- Free Events \$ 2,000
- Events Fundraisers \$ 2,000
- PAC Operations \$500
- Physical Education and Activities \$1000
- Technology \$2,000
- Teacher Fund \$2,500
- Field Trips \$5,500
- Parent Engagement \$1,000
- Contingency \$ 1,000

Total: \$19, 500* (Note this is an estimate and will depend on our fundraising efforts, and expenses. By approving the budget, PAC Executive has authorization and any changes will need to be amended during PAC meetings. Also, the PAC is waiting for the Provincial Government to provide a gaming grant which will offset expenses.
