Description: English 8 provides students with,

- an opportunity to develop their writing and critical thinking skills through a variety of different mediums such as personal narrative, persuasive, expository and descriptive writing,
- examples of how stories help us understand ourselves, define ourselves and how stories that are shared with others bring us all closer together,
- an understanding of why oral traditions is so important to First Nations and what skills are needed for effective oral communication.
- an opportunity to complete a novel study that focuses on the costs and benefits of conformity or nonconformity within a peer group, and how a person's relationship with his/her peers affect the kind of person he/she will become.
