The Fashion Industry 12 course is an integral component of the Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies curriculum. This course offers you the opportunity to explore careers in the fashion and design industry. Various career paths within the fashion and apparel industry, spanning production, marketing, design, research & development will be discussed throughout the course.

If you're interested in the fashion industry or considering a career in it, you may need to submit a portfolio for admission to post-secondary design programs, such as Kwantlen Polytechnic University's ' **Fashion Design & Technology Program**'. This course helps prepare students for potential enrollment by guiding them in portfolio development. While Unit 1 outlines the portfolio requirements for admission.

As you work through the projects in this course, you can start to collect and save material that you will add to this portfolio. It's important to note that creating a portfolio is not mandatory for this course. You won't be submitting a portfolio at the end of this course, but rather building it for your own personal development.
