

Course: Law Studies 12

Description: Law Studies 12 introduces you to the legal rights and responsibilities which allow citizens to participate more fully in society. Laws maintain the status quo, but they can also be a force for change. You will examine how laws have changed over time and the social attitudes and legal processes involved in bringing about these changes. Canada's laws and legal framework affect many aspects of your daily life. The more you understand the laws that govern your life, the easier it is to navigate through daily events. Each of the four units in the course, Foundations of Law, Criminal Law, Civil Law and Rights, Family and Aboriginal Law consist of lessons, activities and unit tests.
