Description: In Social Studies 10, you will be learning about the history of Canada as an independent nation from the beginning of World War I right up until the early 21st century. By the beginning of this century, we came to be known for our strong democratic principles, our leadership, high standard of living, multicultural society and strong, stable economy. You will also be completing a regional study of BC with a specific focus on the history of Chinese Canadians in BC. You will need to think critically to understand the complete picture of past events, and how they have shaped our present and what it is that makes Canadians who we are.
