

The **Live It Earth** bilingual resource focuses on place-based learning experiences using digital storytelling methods. The resource offers video-rich programming informed by Indigenous perspectives and supplemented by extensive instructional supports.

### RELEVANT PROGRAMS

Each season includes **eight new or updated programs**, which are added to the content catalogue. All programs include teacher timelines, checklists, and PD support.

Create personalized collections to match **language, grade level, and BC curricular interests**, and to learn from **local First Nations communities**.

### FEATURED TOPICS

**Climate-focused programs** include Glaciers, Energy, Forests, Weather, Farming, and Oceans, as well as Salmon, Orcas, Arctic Fox, Belugas, Narwhals, and the Grey Wolf.

**Featured places and communities** include the Arctic, Deep Sea, St. Lawrence Estuary, Mackenzie Delta, Cheslatta Carrier First Nation, and W̱SÁNEĆ First Nations.

### PRIOR KNOWLEDGE

Before watching the 20- to 30-minute **feature show** with experts in the field, explore the introductory slideshow, **Glossary**, and **Inquiry Guide** with students.

Use the provided **Creative and STEM Challenges** to build engagement and cross-curricular connections.

### POST-VIEWING ACTIVITIES

Following the feature show, explore further with **Deep Dives**, and **Live It 360°** interactive experiences. Engage in **Story** and **Game Challenges**.

Students can undertake **self-assessment**, accept each program's **Call to Action**, and explore career pathways.
