- Motion to begin meeting at 6:05pm by Preet. Seconded by Suzy.
- Student Council Presentation
 - The Grade 7 students shared details of the various events and activities they put on for the school this past year including walk to school, healthy snack weeks, fit kids, colouring contests, scavenger hunts, spirit weeks, mental health awareness and the library mural.

• Grade 7 Grad Update – Mr. Mohammed

- The Grade 7 students are looking forward to various year end activities including potential field trips to playland and sandcastle lanes bowling. Unfortunately, the traditional Chimney Hill Victoria field trip is not feasible this year due to increased fuel costs.
- Discussions are taking place regarding the graduation event for the end of the year, however it is hard to plan at this time as there is uncertainty about what protocols will be in place at the end of June.
- The Grade 7 students have been brainstorming themes for their grad event and have narrowed options down to four and will be taking a final vote.
- The annual garage sale fundraiser will not be happening this year, and instead of grade 7 parents donating their time, they are being asked to donate funds towards the grade 7 year end activities
 - Prior to Covid, the grade 7 students would raise about \$2000 and would receive funding from PAC for an additional \$2000 (field trip fund, profits from pizza sale, etc).
 - The Grade 7 fund currently has about \$900 from PAC (\$300 of which was donated by parents last year).
- Mr. Mohammed requests the left-over Fit Kids equipment funding (\$995) be reallocated towards Grade 7 Grad (most of it for medals).
 - The money was initially being saved for the Fit Kids clock but the repair did not end up costing that much.

- As health and safety protocols are lifting, Chimney Hill is happy to welcome parents back into the building
- The school is organizing a scaled back running club to run in May
- School garden update
 - The ground is prepped (replaced with black gravel) by the Chimney Hill wooden sign
 - Gardening bins have been received and the soil is coming in on Monday
 - Plants are being delivered and the garden should be planted by Tuesday
 - There is a bench for seating currently, but Admin is looking at adding stones/boulders for additional seating
- The Sports Day committee will be created at the upcoming staff meeting
 - Parents are invited to attend as this is an outdoor event. Will be held on Friday June 10th
- Fall Back to School Update
 - Staff are currently planning for the 2022/23 school year
 - Enrollment information is coming in from the district to help organize classes for the fall
