• Principal's Report – Ms. Reiter

- o Goals for this year
 - get new technology into classrooms using samosa sales as fundraising opportunities in October and November
 - playground replacement as playground is due to expire and be taken down in 2026. Currently the slide has been removed and cannot be replaced. A barrier has been placed on the slide opening to prevent any accidents. Playground replacement will cost \$100,000 and the Area Superintendent is providing information on grants. Donors may be sought and recognized by having a plate with their name on a bench. Want to make the playground accessible for all children. Once there is more information, a presentation may be arranged by Admin for information and feedback.

Discussion occurred regarding class placements and the process of class placements at the district and school levels. Parents asked questions and offered suggestions on how to make the process less challenging for children. Information regarding how to help children with their anxiety would be helpful.

Parents expressed the challenges some of their children faced with being in split classes (one parent spoke specifically about concerns about a Kindergarten/Grade 1 split) and the number of split classes at the grade 6 level.
