Peer conflict vs Bullying

- Is it bullying?
 - Every report is taken very seriously by School Administration
 - Investigate
 - Talk to staff and students
 - More often than not, it is considered conflict
- Closer look @conflict
 - Natural part of human relationship
 - Conflict is not bullying
 - Conflict happens between equals
 - Escalate into big disagreement
 - Might be strong feeling
 - Often small things reported as bullying
 - We stay curious and ask questions
 - We want to be careful not to create victims

Language & Skills to Help Students

- Calm down strategize size of problem etc
- Red, Yellow, Green Zone used
- At CTS we believe all children should be treated with compassion and dignity
- We do not share information about other families to protect their privacy
- Discourage gossip and playground or online chatter about family or student
- How would you feel if your child is labeled as a bully?
