Principal's Report –Amy Newman

- Amy started off thanking the PAC for supporting hot lunches. Staff and kids so appreciate it they look forward to the hot lunches.
- CTS technology replacement of \$6,000 thank you to PAC. Laptop upgrades is where most of the funds will be used
- Ms Kaushal 4/5 class on Wednesday with Ms. Lagore who will be here until June
- Mr. Simonus 6/7 Wed sharing with Ms. Lyne
- K registration for 2022 Jan 24- Feb 10
- We had an opening as a couple of families moved etc. A parent came to school today had been waiting for 3 years to get in, she was so excited.
- COVID: seeing a rise in staff and student absences, approximately 1-3 teachers absent.
- Teacher absent no TOC but we have been able to fill. This has been happening since we opened.
- Kids seem to be missing in pockets
- Most classes have 1-5 kids absent
- Fraser Health can't keep up with contact tracing
- Have to share with Health and Safety when someone is not there. Ms. Staite/Ms. Van Dyke/Ms. Haze and myself(Mrs. Newman) We are the people that know who are away and why.
- So common now everyone that's away, assume it is due to Covid
- Fraser Health is looking at attendance very closely.

- CTS daily health checks in place: if kids have any of the symptoms are unusual, please keep the child at home
 - Unwell/nauseated
 - Headache
 - Scratchy throat
 - Runny nose
- Air purifiers
 - Medical Health Officer indicated that they cannot be deployed at this time
 - We will just have to wait
- Isolation was 14 days, then 10, now 5 days self isolation or until you feel well to come back to school
- Robust three layer mask recommended but seeing more KN95/94 masks being worn.
- Rapid tests (2) are coming for every staff member
- Functional closure only if 25% absent that means 4 teachers for CTS. In this case a call is made to the Superintendent and they investigate, before deciding on functional closure
