Below is very important information about our return to school. Please read carefully and contact us if you have any questions. Please check our school website regularly for updates and information.

Questions and Answers

Q: Where does my child go on the first day of school?

A: Our first day of school is Tuesday September 6. The purpose of this first day is to welcome families and students back and confirm attendance so we can begin the important process of organizing classes. Please refer to the designated classrooms below to see where to **drop-off and pick-up** your child on the first day.

Q: My child is new to Frost Road Elementary. Where do they go?

A: Your child should meet in the grade locations indicated above. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to reach out to a staff member outside who will be wearing a bright vest.

Q: I have not yet registered my child. How do I do this?

A: All registration is now done online. To register your child, please go to <u>www.surreyschools.ca</u>, click on parents' tab found at the top of the page in the purple highlighted section, then go to student registration.

Q: Why is there no Kindergarten supply list?

A: It is typical for schools to purchase bulk supplies for Kindergarten students. Our Kin dergarten teachers will be asking for \$40 per student and will be available thru school cash online (information below on how to register).

Q: What grades use agendas and planners?

A: At Frost Road, grades 1 – 7 use agendas and planners. The cost for a planner is \$5.00 and will be available through school cash online (information below on how to register).

Q: When will I know what class my child is in?

A: We will be working diligently during the first week of school to welcome students, confirm numbers and organize classes. Organizing classes is a very important process that requires adequate time and patience. You can anticipate information regarding class placement no later than the end of the second week of school.

National Day for Truth and Reconciliation

New Frost Road Website

To download the app from an android phone, go to google play store, search for Surrey Schools.

To download the app from an i-phone, go the apple store, search for Surrey Schools, please see picture of app to the right for what you are looking for.

For your information: the SchoolLink mobile app. has been replaced by the new Surrey Schools app.

Once you have downloaded the app as shown above and are in the app. click **Menu** and then click **Content Sources**. In addition to district news from Surrey Schools, pick which school(s) you want to receive your news and updates from.

Click Next.

To receive push notifications, make sure that you enable notifications. In the app. click **Menu** then click **Settings.** Select what notifications you want to receive (Notifications, News and/or Events) and ensure **Push Notifications** is set to **On.**

Click **Home** (bottom of your device display) to view the news from your selected sites.

Click **Calendar** to view the calendar events from your selected sites.

Click **Menu** where you can adjust your notification settings. Click the back arrow to return to the previous menu.

Click **Content Sources** to select or deselect the name of sites that you would like to view the content for.

School Supplies for 2022-2023 School Year



Your student school supply packs can be ordered ONLINE at:

You can still order your school supplies and they will be sent by Canada Post to your residence - There will be an additional \$12.00 fee for delivery

Part A: The essential pack with items chosen by your teacher/school. This comes as a package deal with all items listed included. Items cannot be changed, substituted, or omitted

Part B items: You MUST have all Part B items. Individual items may be purchased from Creative Children by adding them to your Pack order or bring them in from home.

Part B and/or C items must be ordered at the SAME TIME as the Part A pack. You cannot come back to the website and order Part B items separately.

Payment types accepted are VISA, MasterCard, Vanilla Prepaid VISA or MasterCard gift card or PayPal.

School Cash Online



Frost Road offers *School Cash Online*, which provides you with the convenience, easy, and quick way of paying online for school items such as trips, club/athletic fees, and spirit wear, which is the preferred method of paying for items. *School Cash Online* is a great way to pay without the need for cash or cheques!

Which payment methods are accepted?

Credit Card, Debit Card or eCheck (an electronic version of a paper check used to make payments online. Anyone with a chequing or savings account can pay by **eCheck** on SchoolCashOnline.

To register online:

Step 1: Visit our school website at: (www.surreyschools.ca/frostroad)

Step 2: Click on the "Parent" tab and select "Pay Fees Online".

Step 3: Register by selecting the "Get Started Now" and follow the steps.

Step 4: After you receive the confirmation email, select the "click here" option, **login in and add each of** your children to your household account.

Once you have registered your child, you will be able to see when they have a new item posted online for purchase. You also have the option to be notified whenever your child has a new school expense due, so you don't have to worry about missing the deadline.
