New business

Uniform Vendor:

-Current vendor has a lot of stock. The current vendor has suggested a blowout sale. His stock will be on sale at a discounted price. Carin will pick dates with the vendor and the plan is to have the sale in June, in the school gym.

-Michelle will be meeting with A1 sports tomorrow to finalize pricing for uniforms. Carin will connect with the district in regards to a contract. All contracts need to go through the district. A one year contract was suggested so that we can make sure the service and product is satisfactory.

Principals Report:

-Thank you to PAC members and all the volunteers this year, for bringing in lacross and curling. There has been positive feedback from staff and students.

-A reminder to all parents to please drive slowly and carefully in the school parking lot. Today, one of the teachers was almost hit by a car while she was supervising the crosswalk. We all need to think about each other's safety at all times.

-There will be changes to staffing in September. Mr. White and Mr. Jones will be retiring this year. They will be greatly missed. Carin is in the process of interviewing applicants.

Refrigerator/Freezer: Michelle has shopped around for fridge and freezer at Costco. Costco will provide free delivery and can have the fridge delivered as early as next week. PAC has decided to purchase fridge for now and will wait to purchase freezer. Motion brought forward by Vandita to allocate \$1000 maximum to purchase a new fridge. Motion seconded by Aman. Motion passed.

PAC account currently has approximately \$3,300.

Fundraising:

-Principal for a day was a huge success. A grade 4 student was chosen and was really excited for this opportunity. Students liked this idea so much that they are requesting this to be a yearly contest. PAC raised \$694 from this fundraiser.

-Michelle is in talks with the Vancouver Bandits for a fundraising opportunity. The Bandits play out of the Langley Events center. The organization is offering \$7.00 from each ticket sale to go to PAC. Tickets for games start at \$20. The Bandits will provide PAC with a website link for families to buy tickets that is linked with the fundraiser. Michelle is looking into having the Bandits come to the school for a meet and greet.

-PAC will have a sports day concession again this year. We are looking for parent volunteers to help with the concession stand. PAC will have 2 tables, so that the line up will be quicker and parents will not get overwhelmed with the crowds. Michelle has last years menu and Joy has started some of the shopping.

-A parent brought up an idea for a food truck picnic on the school grounds. Carin will check with the school district about guidelines regarding food trucks and check field availability. Sometimes the district rents out the fields on weekends.

Gaming grant: Aman has completed the gaming application for next school years funding. The decision to approve/deny will come in the fall. Last years application is not approved. Appeal was also denied.
