- Concession is making approximately \$100-150 per week
- Movie night made \$900 profit
- Smencils made \$974 profit
- Parent social \$4100 profit
- First aid course \$900 profit
- Purdy's \$527 profit
- Gaming grant applied for (\$10,000), can be used for only specific things - will be used for Grade 7 grad ceremony, Saleema Noon, Grade 7 lunch/beach trip
- Miyoung to look into E-account for PAC - would be \$6/month and unlimited e-transfer.
- Teacher request - \$10,000 for tech each year - next year PAC's prime goal is for outdoor learning but may be able to accommodate both, also would like \$20 per student for in school experiences as school no longer able to ask parents to pay for these
- Discussed a second day of the week for hot lunch to be able to fundraise more, possibly with no option for add-ons (ie. juices, treats, concession items) to make distribution easier and less sugary items - option to discuss further with teachers/pac about positive/negatives
