- \$1230 away from cougar creek trip - looking into community businesses to fund deficit
- Tech funds spent - computers have not arrived yet
- Teacher funding is currently \$200 per division, band etc.
- School discretionary fund \$500 (Principal/VP)
- Making less this year with Spirit wear/Purdy's
- Rocket fuel/Student family assistance government funding - Government funding could be used for covering costs of hot lunch to students in need
- In school experience funds can be broadened instead of smaller categories to help relocate funds that aren't being used in certain areas (sports instruction to stay separate)
- Principal to look into the deficit for in school activities that were previously paid for by parents so PAC can budget for these costs in the future
- Free Santa breakfast, menchie's events, etc are coming from school fundraising revenue money, not from allocated budget
- Recent concern from a RHE community member regarding budget spending - Recommendation from DPAC Treasurer that teachers submit their requests for needs first before allocating funds to each classroom
