- Ordering is live

- Vendors paired up to allow more selection and allow smaller vendors to accommodate orders
- Food costs have increased. Some vendors cut due to increased prices
- Costs are similar to last year to keep affordable but will affect profits
- Approx \$20,000 total made last year on hot lunch
- Parent volunteers will distribute lunches, students will hand out lunches only if no parent volunteers are available. Class parents to inform Dana if no one available for upcoming Hot lunch day distribution in any divisions
- Paper notices to be distributed in planners regarding Hot lunch ordering
- Sign ups will be posted for classes up to grade 5. Will let grade 6&7 teachers decide if they would like to have a sign up for parent volunteers for hot lunch
