- Student and family assistance program not available this year to use for hot lunch. Rocket fuel is still an option to cover families who need support with hot lunch.
- Karen Kaufman will be doing a few cookie dates. \$3/cookie. Booked for Christmas, Halloween and Dhawali
- Babysitter course on October 20th Pro-d day. Requested gym and music room to use. There will be some staff onsite. Course has increased in price from \$45-53
- Rainbow crosswalk Ashley looking into funding from the surrey pride society and what approvals we would need
- Inflatables for carnival/winter fest are they allowed now? May not bedue to new policies. David will look into.
- Halloween dance proposed due to parents needing to be there, would do primary and intermediate separate to keep capacity numbers within limit. Costume prizes, pumpkin carving contest, DJ Marissa?, will check to see if parent chaperones are required or how many supervisors for a group of kids. Would be held on October 27th
