Ombudsman Survey

- Influx of reporting on exclusions in the district - Survey to be kept open to allow for more voices to be heard

Budget Cuts

- Budget must be balanced, there is a major shortfall this coming year. \$900 million shortfall from the ministry, voices are being raised, provincial problem. Board meeting happening May 14th.
- Parent led rally to happen at district office (Currently May 16, may move to the 14th, day of meeting)
- Losing 50 IESW positions in September, 1000 IESW days are going unfilled per month
- DPAC is fighting for our most vulnerable students, parents need to demand more from the district, talk to their MLAs
- Surrey School district getting new treasurer, will hopefully help with budget

 All field trips to the USA have been paused for now for safety and security reasons due to the situation surrounding customs and immigration at the US border
