## Kindergarten Registration Starts...

It's time to register for KINDERGARTEN. Those children who will turn 5 before January 1, 2025 are eligible to begin school in September 2024. Registration will begin on Monday, January 15<sup>th</sup> and can be done through the online school District website.

To register, take pictures (to attach) or (scan and attach) the citizenship for both the parent and your child, proof of residency, and proof of guardianship. For proof of residency, we require any three of the following: purchase or rental agreement, income tax statement, property tax statement, utility bill, drivers licence, Care Card, BC identification or a signed letter form your landlord. These can also be scanned and attached (or take pictures to attach).

It is very important to register as quickly as possible as the District bases the teacher allocation based on our enrollment. Thank you for your assistance in getting registrations in as soon as possible.

We recommend that all students bring water bottles and lunches to school daily in the morning. If you need to drop off a lunch, please label the lunches and place them on the table in the hall by the office.



#### Parent Visitor Protocol

All visitors must report to the office of the school due to safety reasons. One of our office staff will be happy to assist you. You can contact your child's teacher to make an appointment if necessary.



## School Closures Information...

Sometimes extreme weather conditions or other circumstances can cause class cancellations at a school, or district wide on short notice. The District will do its best to communicate the status of schools by 7:00 am.

If there is a closure mid day for any reason, we will keep all students until parents or guardians are contacted and pick up occurs. All students should check in to the office and should never return home on their own without contact made by the school staff. **Please discuss this safety protocol with your children.** 

## **Basketball Season**

**Illness Protocols** 

If your child is not feeling well please do a daily health check to determine if they should stay home. If your children are repeatedly coughing, sneezing or have flu like symptoms, it would be better to keep them at home. We do not want ill students to pass on their illness to other students or staff. Thank you in advance for your understanding.

## **Black Excellence Day**

Monday, January 15<sup>th</sup> is Black Excellence Day which aims to highlight past and present struggles of Black and other racialized Canadians. Black Excellence Day is a new initiative in BC and aims to spark important conversations about antiracism and unity among various ethnic groups. Our students will be learning about Black Canadians that have had a positive impact in Canada in different areas in January and February. Some classes will also log on to an online Black Excellence Day presentation.





### **Weather News**

Please make sure your child is dressed for the weather. We try to give all students a play break and fresh air at Recess and Lunch. We will only have an inside day during extreme weather conditions. Some students have had to call home to get a change of clothes after Recess or Lunch as they have slipped and fallen. It is not a bad idea to have a change of clothes at the school or in their backpack, particularly the primary students.

## Scent Allergies...

Some staff and students are allergic to the chemicals that are in many scented products like shampoos, perfumes, hand creams, lotions and deodorants. Please do not wear scented products at



school as it is having a negative impact on their health.

## Cell Phone Use...



Cell phones have become a distraction for some of our students. The need to get on social media and communication groups through apps like Discord and Snapchat has become a concern for staff at the school. If you choose to send your child with a phone for safety reasons, the phones should be kept in backpacks and only used before and after school to connect with parents. We have school phones at the office or classroom if they need to get a hold of parents. In addition, we have school computers and ipads that teachers book for educational activities. Cell phones do not need to be carried around with students and if they are out it is only when used in the class under the direct supervision of the Classroom Teacher. Phones can be locked up in the teachers cupboard so they are not lost or misused. We have had issues with some students using their phones for non educational reasons. If your child uses their phone inappropriately they may be asked to not bring it to school again. This includes any phone use in bathrooms or taking pictures or videos of others without proper consent.

## Drop off and Pick Up Safety Policy..

Please drive slow and safe when dropping off and picking up your child near the school grounds. In addition:



- ALWAYS HAVE YOUR CHILDREN EXIT TO THE SIDEWALK SIDE OF THE VEHICLE
- Never open the door to the interior of the street to exit out as cars may be passing
- Please drive slowly in front of the school.
- Look both ways before exiting the drop off area to go back in the passing lane
- Do not double park on the street as it creates unnecessary congestion
- Park one block down the street and walk to pick up your children
- Watch carefully for pedestrians and please obey the crossing guard signals.
