Ramadan / Eid

This month some of our staff and student have been fasting. Muslims believe that this is the month in which God revealed the first verses of the Quran to Muhammad, who is considered the final prophet of Islam. So for 30 days, those who observe, fast from dawn to dusk. This year Fasting began on March 10 and will end on April 8. Ramadan lasts between 29 - 30 days and it always ends with the arrival of Eid al-Fitr which literally translates to 'festival of breaking the fast'. Eid al-Fitr is expected to fall on Friday, April 9, and end on the evening of April 10.

If you wish to, you may wear cultural dress on April 9 or 10.
