Parent Visitor Protocol

Lunches/Water Bottles

Truth and Reconciliation and Federal Holiday...

Each year, The National Day for Truth and Reconciliation takes place on September 30. This day is meant to honour Canada's residential school survivors, their families and communities. The holiday publicly commemorates the history and ongoing legacy of the schools. In honour of this day, we will be holding Orange Shirt Day on Friday, September 29th. Monday, October 1 is a Federal Holiday and schools will be closed.



Crossing Guards and Frontiersman...

We have two amazing Frontiersman that help our families cross the roads on Fir Street and Johnston. Please watch for them and follow their signals carefully. We are looking for a Frontiersman on Roper Avenue. Frontiersman will receive a \$27 stipend from the City for their volunteer work per day. Drop off and Pick Up Safety Policy...

- ALWAYS HAVE YOUR CHILDREN EXIT TO THE SIDEWALK SIDE OF THE VEHICLE
- Never open the door to the interior of the street to exit out as cars may be passing
- Please drive slowly in front of the school.
- Look both ways before exiting the drop off area
- Do not double park on the street
- Do not overpass a stopped car as they may be stopped for students to cross
- Park one block down the street and walk to pick up your children
- Use the drop off and pick area in the parking lot with caution





School Closures Information...

Sometimes extreme weather conditions or other circumstances can cause class cancellations at a school, or district wide on short notice. In the event of class cancellations, the Surrey School District will post information on its web site at www.surreyschools.ca and provide updates to the following radio stations:

The District will do its best to communicate the status of schools by 7:00 am.

Sometimes the decision to send students home if they have care can come to us close to the entry bell. We will always keep all students who are without parents and contact you by phone for safe pick up. All students should check in to the office and should never return home on their own without contact made by the school staff. **Please discuss this safety protocol with your children.**

Inclement Weather and Change of Clothes...

The weather can be unpredictable at different times of the year. Please check the weather in the morning and ensure that your child is dressed appropriately. Please be careful when walking to school as the ground may be wet, icy and slippery. If you are dropping off or picking up your child please follow Safe Drop Off guidelines. Have a waiting spot for picking up your child. For younger children, a change of clothes in the in bag or in the classroom is recommended.

Lunch begins Thursday Sept 28, and will be available once per week.

Lunch is ordered in 3 Terms (Fall, Winter, Spring).

Parents will need to **ORDER & PAY by Thursday Sept 21 at midnight** if they wish to order a fundraiser lunch any time between Sept 28- December 21.

Payment options are by credit card or etransfer.

You will need to set up an account and register your children if you haven't used the platform already. You will need your child's teacher and division to register

Additional Information:

- Hot lunch is a PAC fundraiser, run by volunteer parents. Please let us know if you are able to help.
- Price mark up on lunches is very small (on average \$0.50 per item ordered). Cost of food/ordering has increased but the team has worked very hard to try to give affordable options for parents who wish to order.
- There are <u>no refunds</u> for Hot lunch days. If your child is sick or away on a day hot lunch is ordered, you can make arrangements with the teacher or another child to bring the lunch home, or it can be picked up from the school by lunch time the next day (Friday).
- At the end of the year, if parents have mistakenly overpaid, PAC will refund amounts over \$5.00. Anything less, PAC will use as a donation.
- Parents who order hot lunch will receive a weekly email reminder from munchalunch.
